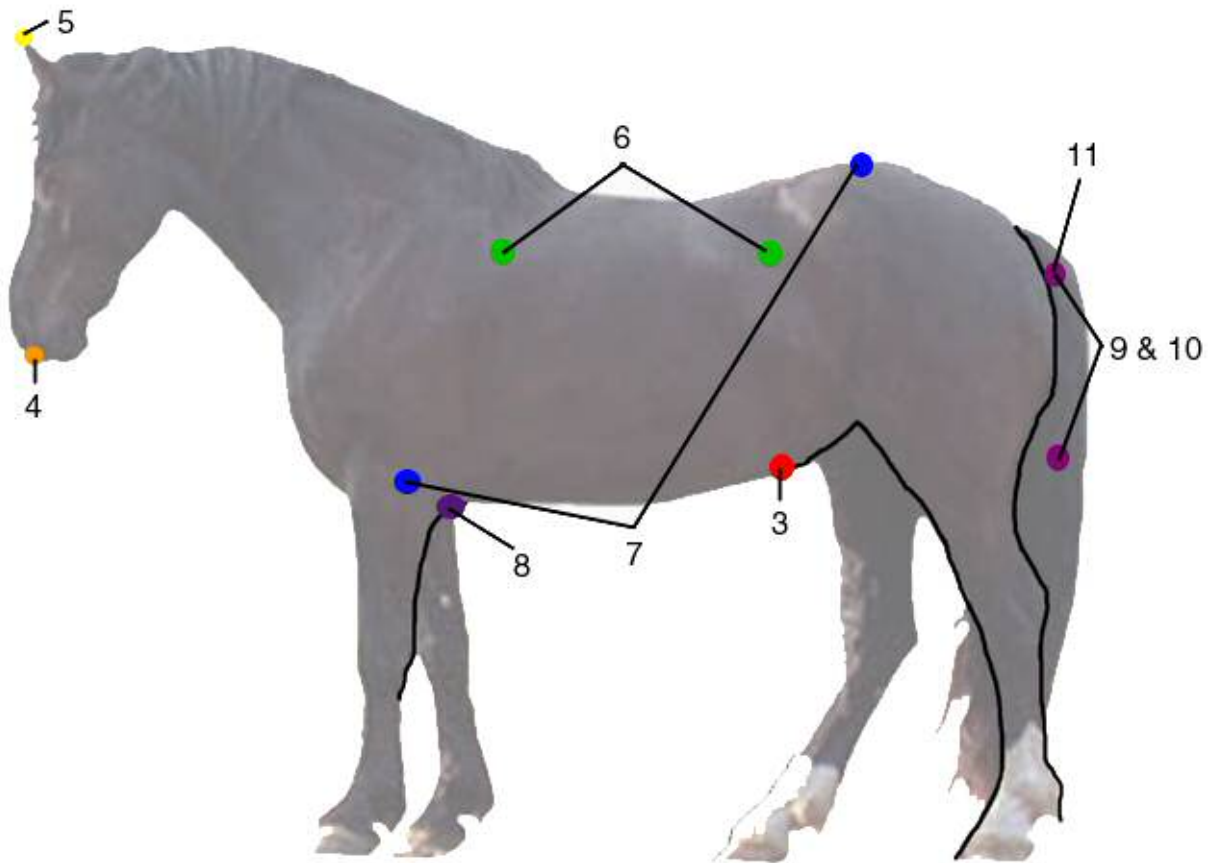




The Colic Support Chart

The following are the procedures you can take to help a horse with colic until the vet arrives.

Associated Procedure/ Number	Color of Point and location on chart	Description/Action/Motions of Hands or Fingers
i First thing that must always be done is call the Vet with vital information; Temperature, Respiration, Heart Rate		
1		Mouth 20 cc's of Dyna-Pro ¹ in Mouth
2		Mouth 15 Sprays of Relax ² in Mouth
3	Red	Navel Ditone ³ – 4 Drops on navel and surrounding area Listen for gut sounds – Left side = low on belly Right side = high in front of flank Apply 4 drops of Ditone ³ to side(s) without sounds.
4	Orange	Upper Lip Clockwise small circles on point above lip and below nostrils.

5	Yellow	Ears	Ditone ³ (1 drop on each ear tip) Stroke ear up wards from base to tip, ending with small clockwise circles on tip of each ear.
6	Green	Upper Sides	South Fingers (Right hand Forefinger/Left hand Middle Finger) on each point – Hold until pulse is even on each finger – do on both sides of horse
7	Blue	Forearm and Top of Hip	North finger (Right hand = Middle finger/Left hand Fore finger) on top point: South finger (Right hand Forefinger/Left hand Middle Finger) on lower point – Hold until pulse is even on each finger – do on both sides of horse.
8	Indigo	Between Front Legs	Belly/Wither Lifts between front legs – Hold till horse's head comes down – relaxed.
9	Violet	Tail	Pick up tail with 1 st 2 fingers – with other hand pull down bottom tip of tailbone.
10	Violet	Tail	Tail Pull – <u>GENTLY!</u> – Hold tail at top and below bone and pull GENTLY
11	Violet	Tail	Message area where hair ends on both sides. Watch for tail to raise and gas to release.
12			Repeat Steps 1 to 11 until vets arrives. i Note: Steps 1, 2, 3 can be repeated every 30 minutes if needed.
13			If Vet is still needed and tubing with oil is recommended, use 2 TBSP of NTM Salt ⁴ mixed with 1 gallon of warm water to tube into stomach.
